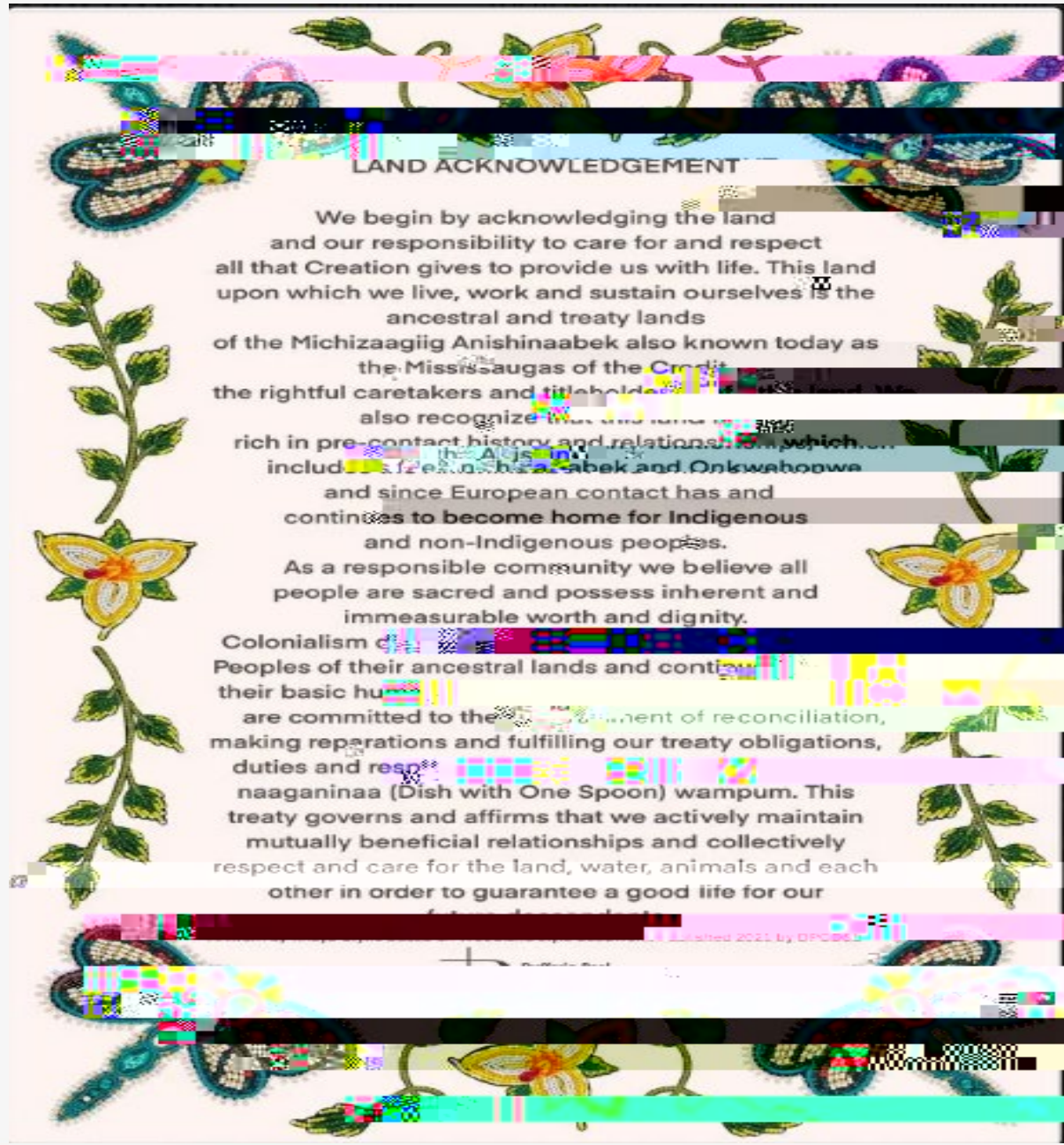

# Land Acknowledgement



## LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Busing distances:

- Kindergarten to Grade 1: 1.0 km
- Grades 2 to 4: 1.6 km
- Grades 5 to 8: 2.0 km
- Secondary (9-12): 3.8 km
